MS SQL Server 2005 and Microsoft XP - Early Warning of dropping support

In 2014, Microsoft will be releasing SQL 2014. Our policy for supporting versions of MS SQL is to support the latest 3 versions only.

This is to allow us to take advantage of the latest features available within MS SQL server, to deliver benefit to the users. Because SQL 2008 R2 was released so soon after SQL 2008, we have continued to support SQL 2005. However, from 01 July 2014, any new release of Access software that uses MS SQL server will not be supported on this version of SQL.

Please take careful note that any upgrades scheduled in and around this date should also be considering an upgrade to the SQL server at the same time, to ensure compatibility going forward.

In addition in April 2014 Microsoft are terminating the extended support agreement for Windows XP. As such from 1st July 2014, we will also be dropping support for all Access Software running on XP. The software currently installed will continue to work, but any future upgrades will not have been tested on this platform.

Please take careful note that any upgrades scheduled in and around this date should also be considering an upgrade to their Windows operating system at the same time, to ensure compatibility going forward.
